

New wins buoy plans for fit-outs

WEST design and fit-out group Spacetailors has won contracts worth more than £2 million in the past couple of months.

The Cheltenham company, which built its reputation refurbishing cinemas, has won the new business in sectors including retail, corporate, leisure, hospitality and education.
